## INFORMATION TO PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, CANVASSERS

HOURS OF OPERATION: It shall be unlawful for any peddler, solicitor or canvasser to engage in business with the village between the hour of 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. the following morning, or at any time on Sundays, except by specific appointment with or invitation from the prospective customer. It shall be unlawful for a peddler to enter upon any private premises when such premises are posted with sign state "NO PEDDLERS ALLOWED" or "NO SOLICITATIONS ALLOWED" or other words to such effect.

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in business as a speddler with this village without first obtaining a license to do so. A license can be applied for between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, Municipal Building, Room 17.

At the time of filing the application for a peddler's permit, the applicant shall present his/her drivers license, if he/she has one, and two (2) 2"x 1" head and shoulder photographs ID taken within 60 days to the village clerk's office.

<u>CONVICTION INFORMATION</u>: The applicant shall provide information as to any conviction. Official proof of disposition may be required at the request of the Clerk/Treasurer. Conviction information should include dates, crime convicted of, court/location of the conviction.

FALSE INFORMATION: It shall be unlawful for any person to give any false or misleading information in connection with his/her application for a peddler's permit.

<u>FINGERPRINTS:</u> At the time of making application, the applicant shall submit to fingerprinting by the police department, located at 2395 Elmwood Avenue, Kenmore, New York.

<u>VEHICLE:</u> Any vehicle used as part of the business shall be described and registration provided. A copy of the applicant's driver's license shall also be submitted with the application.

BOND: Every applicant who will be requiring cash deposits or taking orders for cash-on-delivery purchases (COD) or who requires a contract of agreement to finance the sale of any goods, services or merchandise for future delivery or for services to be performed in the future shall furnish to the Clerk a bond running to the Village in such amount as established by local law or resolution, with surety acceptable to and approved by the village attorney, conditioned that the applicant shall comply fully with all the applicable provisions of the Code, the laws of the village and state laws regulating and concerning the business of peddling. Action on such bond may be brought in the name of the village to the use or benefit of any aggrieved person.

TERM: A peddler's permit license shall expire sixty (60) days from its date of issuance.

TRANSFER: No peddler's permit shall be transferable.

<u>DISPLAY:</u> Every peddler having a license issued under the provisions of this article and doing business within the village shall display his/her license upon the request of any person, and failure to do so shall be deemed a misdemeanor.

SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION: Any license issued pursuant to the provisions of this law may be revoked or suspended by the Village Clerk/Treasurer if there is cause to believe that the holder of such license is violating any statute of the state or any provisions of this law.

Upon such revocation or suspension, the Village Clerk/Treasurer, shall cause notice to be served upon the holder of the peddler's permit, specifying the grounds for the revocation of such license. The holder shall be entitled to a hearing before the Board of Trustees of the Village, if requested, within fourteen (14) days following notice of revocation. The holder shall be afforded the opportunity at such hearing to present evidence and witnesses in his/her behalf in connection with his/her license. Following such hearing, the board shall render a determination of the license within twenty (20) days. Said determination shall set forth in writing and shall state the grounds therefore.
