SINATRA PROPERTIES UPDATE

Building Inspector, Michael Berns, informed the Board that all of the Sinatra Realty properties are being sold. The new owner, Tony Trusso, owns other property in the Village and is eager to address these properties. They will be using the same paint color pallet.

The LaDavina wall is deteriorated. The sign will be removed and wall repaired. They may be getting a new sign. The new owner will also be addressing the properties located between the banks.

1599 KENMORE AVENUE – JOYFUL DOG FRONT FACADE

Malory Johnson, applicant is present. Her business has received an Erie County Storefront Improvement Grant. They'll be keeping the old sign. She says that their building is tucked back and needs more visibility.

Building Inspector Michael Berns explained that they need to present a rendering which shows how the building will look. He said that this paperwork was probably included with their application to Erie County when they applied for the grant. This architect rendering should be submitted to the Planning Board for review and approval. He also notes that residential siding is not permitted on businesses and that they also need to submit lighting plans.

Ms. Johnson also stated that they hope to cover the glass block. All other windows will be replaced. The rest of the building will be white. There will be no vinyl siding. The "Joyful

Dog" sign is internally lit and on only during the day. The plan also includes a new door. The current door brings a draft into the lobby.
